**2009-10 KANSAS BPA PARENT/YOUTH &  
PARENT/TEEN TOURNAMENT**

**ELIGIBILITY – AGES**

**YOUTH BOWLERS – PARENT/YOUTH DIVISION** – USBC certified bowlers who are 12 years of age or younger as of August 1, 2009.

**PARENT/TEEN DIVISION** – USBC certified bowlers who are 13 through 18 years of age as of August 1, 2009.

**ADULT BOWLERS** – Adults who are USBC certified bowlers prior to bowling and have reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday as of August 1, 2009.

**ELIGIBILITY**

**YOUTH BOWLERS** – May bowl in this tournament with their USBC Certified parents, grandparents, step-parents, step-grandparents, great grandparents, step great grandparents or court-appointed legal guardians only.

**ADULT BOWLERS** – Any bowler competing as an adult who has competed three (3) times in the national finals of any BPAA tournament (excluding U.S. Open) is not eligible for this tournament. The same parent/youth, parent/teen team may bowl in the International Finals no more than **twice**. After such time, parents may qualify for the International Finals with another child/grandchild and youth may qualify with another parent/grandparent.

**AVERAGES**

**YOUTH BOWLERS** – Current average or the 2008-09 season-ending average **whichever is higher**. This **does** include qualifying travel league averages. Current averages must be a minimum of 15 games for bowlers in the Teen Division, and 9 games for bowlers in the Youth Division. The state finals average must be an average for at least 21 games, WHICH MAY BE THE March 31, 2010 avg. if the In-House Qualifying avg. was not for 21 games.

**ADULT BOWLERS** – the HIGHEST of the following:

- (1) 2007-08 USBC certified avg. of 21 or more games, or
- (2) 2008-09 USBC certified avg. of 21 or more games, or
- (3) Current USBC certified average of 21 or more games.

Adult entrants who have ever been re-rated, refused a re-rate, or been disqualified in a tournament must report this at every level of this tournament for possible re-rate.

Individuals without a USBC certified league average will be assigned a scratch average of **220**.

**MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION**

Bowlers may compete more than once with the same partner at the CENTER level ONLY. Bowlers may compete only ONCE with the same partner at the Zone and State levels. *Multiple participation will depend on the limitations of tournament management to schedule squads.*

**FEES**

**Center Level** – Determined by each center – PLUS \$4.00 TOTAL FOR NATIONAL & STATE FEES.

**Zone Level** – Determined by each zone – PLUS 4.00 FOR STATE FEES.

**State Level ONLY** - \$25.00 per doubles team.

**HANDICAP**

100% from 440 – based on total team average (*use handicap chart provided*)

HOUSE & ZONE RULES  
PARENT/YOUTH & PARENT/TEEN DIVISIONS

1. The **youth bowlers and adult bowlers in this tournament must be USBC certified members.**
2. **ELIGIBILITY – YOUTH BOWLERS**  
*PARENT/YOUTH DIVISION* – USBC Youth Division members who are 12 years of age or under as of August 1, 2009.  
*PARENT/TEEN DIVISION* – USBC Youth Division members who are 13 through 18 years of age as of August 1, 2009.  
**ELIGIBILITY – ADULT BOWLERS**
  - (A) Only USBC Certified parents, step-parents, grandparents, step-grandparents, great grandparents, step-great grandparents or court-appointed legal guardians.
  - (B) Any bowler competing as an adult who has competed three (3) times in the national finals of any BPAA tournament (excluding U.S. Open) is not eligible for this tournament.
  - (C) The same Parent/Youth or Parent/Teen team may not return to the national finals more than twice. *They may compete through the state finals with the understanding that they cannot advance to the national finals.* A **DOUBLES TEAM ENTERED IN THE PARENT/YOUTH OR PARENT TEEN DIVISIONS IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE ADULT/YOUTH OR ADULT/TEEN TOURNAMENT.**
3. **FORMAT** – Center qualifying is held October 31, 2009, through March 7, 2010 *in BPAA-member centers only.* Advancement from Center to Zone will be on a 1 out of 2 (or any part of 2) entries per Division. Advancement from Zone to State will be on a 1 out of 2 (or any part of 2) entries per Division. Bowlers may compete more than once with the same partner at the CENTER level. Bowlers may compete only ONCE with the same partner at the Zone & State Levels. *Multiple participation will depend on the limitations of tournament management to schedule squads.*
4. **HANDICAP** – 100% of the difference between the bowlers combined averages and 440.
5. **AVERAGES – YOUTH BOWLERS** – Current average, or 2008-09 season-ending average **whichever is higher.** Current average must have been established in certified league play (in one league), *and must include travel league averages.* Current averages must be a minimum of 15 games for bowlers in the Teen Division, and a minimum of 9 games for bowlers in the Youth Division. If the youth bowler has neither of the above averages, he or she must bowl scratch (**220**). Averages set on modified lane conditions (bumpers, shortened lanes, etc.) are not eligible. No sport lane condition averages.
6. **AVERAGES – ADULT BOWLERS** – **HIGHEST** USBC certified average from (1) the 2007-08 season of 21 or more games or (2) the 2008-09 season of 21 or more games or (3) the current certified average of 21 or more games. If the adult bowler has none of the above averages, he or she must bowl scratch (**220**). *Adult entrants who have ever been re-rated, refused a re-rate, or been disqualified in a tournament must report this at every level of the tournament for possible re-rate.*
7. **SUBSTITUTE BOWLERS** – Substitutes are not permitted at any level of this tournament. If for any reason an entrant is not able to advance to any subsequent level of competition with his/her partner, then his/her team spot will be forfeited and the team next in place will be eligible.
8. All matters not covered by these House & Zone Rules will be handled by the Kansas State BPA Tournament Committee, and all decisions of same will be final.

**AVERAGES AT STATE FINALS** – The adult bowler and the youth bowler must use the USBC certified in-house entering average, unless the USBC certified league average through March 31, 2010, of 21 or more games is higher, then that average must be used. **The state finals average must be a USBC certified league average for at least 21 games.** If the adult or youth bowler has neither average, the bowler must bowl scratch (220). *If the average through March 31, 2010, for any bowler is lower than the in-house entering average for 21 games or more, then the in-house entering average will be used at the State Finals.*

**THE WINNING TEAM AND SECOND PLACE TEAM FROM EACH OF THE TWO DIVISIONS WILL RECEIVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO COMPETE IN THE BPAA INTERNATIONAL FAMILY TOURNAMENT TO BE HELD AT EULESS, TEXAS FROM JULY 29-31, 2010. THE 1<sup>ST</sup> AND 2<sup>ND</sup> PLACE TEAMS WILL RECEIVE \$400 REIMBURSEMENT TOWARDS THEIR TRAVEL EXPENSES. IN ADDITION, LODGING, BANQUETS AND ENTERTAINMENT AT THE INTERNATIONAL FINALS LOCATION WILL BE PROVIDED. THE 3<sup>RD</sup> AND 4<sup>TH</sup> PLACE TEAMS IN EACH OF THE TWO DIVISIONS WILL RECEIVE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR \$250 AND \$100 RESPECTIVELY.**

**ELIGIBILITY – AGES**

**YOUTH BOWLERS** – **ADULT/YOUTH DIVISION** – USBC certified bowlers who are 12 years of age or younger as of August 1, 2009.

**ADULT/TEEN DIVISION** – USBC certified bowlers who are 13 through 18 years of age as of August 1, 2009.

**ADULT BOWLERS** – Adults who have reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday as of August 1, 2009. KSBPA rules state **Adult bowlers do not need to be USBC Certified.**

**ELIGIBILITY – ALL BOWLERS**

Youth bowlers may enter the Adult/Youth or Adult/Teen Divisions with their parents, grandparents, great grandparents, step-parents, step-grandparents, step great grandparents or court-appointed legal guardians **ONLY if the adult is not USBC Certified.** If entering with one of these listed relatives or legal guardians when that adult is not USBC Certified, they cannot later enter the Parent-Youth or Parent-Teen Division if that adult later becomes a USBC Certified bowler with the required average. Youth bowlers may enter with any other adult 19 or older as of August 1, 2009, regardless if the adult is or is not USBC Certified

**AVERAGES**

**YOUTH BOWLERS** – Current average or the 2008-09 season-ending average *whichever is higher*. This *does* include qualifying travel league averages. Current averages must be a minimum of 15 games for bowlers in the Teen Division, and 9 games for bowlers in the Youth Division. The state finals average must be an average for at least 21 games, which may be the March 31, 2010 avg. if the In-House Qualifying avg. was not for 21 games.

**ADULT BOWLERS** – the HIGHEST of the following:

- (1) 2007-08 verifiable avg. of 21 or more games, or
- (2) 2008-09 verifiable avg. of 21 or more games, or
- (3) Current verifiable avg. of 21 or more games.

Adult entrants who have ever been re-rated, refused a re-rate, or been disqualified in a tournament must report this at every level of this tournament for possible re-rate.

Individuals without a verifiable league average will be assigned a scratch average of **220**.

- ELIGIBILITY – YOUTH BOWLERS**  
*ADULT/YOUTH DIVISION* – USBC Youth Division members who are 12 years of age or under as of August 1, 2009.  
*ADULT/TEEN DIVISION* – USBC Youth Division members who are 13 through 18 years of age as of August 1, 2009.
- ELIGIBILITY – ADULT BOWLERS** – Adults who have reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday as of August 1, 2009. **Adults do NOT need to be USBC Certified. Parents, Step-parents, Grandparents, Step-grandparents, Great grandparents, Step-great grandparents or court-appointed legal guardians may bowl in the Adult/Youth & Adult/Teen Divisions ONLY if they are NOT USBC Certified Bowlers. If entering with one of these listed relatives or legal guardians when they are not USBC Certified, they cannot later enter the Parent-Youth or Parent-Teen Division if becoming a USBC Certified bowler with the required average.**
- FORMAT** – Center qualifying is held October 31, 2009, through March 7, 2010, *in BPAA-member centers only*. Advancement from Center to Zone will be on a 1 out of 2 (or any part of 2) entries per Division. Advancement from Zone to State will be on a 1 out of 2 (or any part of 2) entries per Division. Bowlers may compete more than once with the same partner at the CENTER level. Bowlers may compete ONCE with the same partner at the Zone & State levels. *Multiple participations will depend on the limitations of tournament management to schedule squads.*
- HANDICAP** – 100% of the difference between the bowlers' combined averages and 440.
- AVERAGES – YOUTH BOWLERS** – Current USBC CERTIFIED average or 2008-09 season-ending average **whichever is higher**. Current average must have been established in certified league play (in one league), *and must include travel league averages*. Current averages must be a minimum of 15 games for bowlers in the Teen Division, and a minimum of 9 games for bowlers in the Youth Division. If the youth bowler has neither of the above averages, he or she must bowl scratch (220). Averages set on modified lane conditions (bumpers, shortened lanes, etc.) are not eligible. No sport lane condition averages. NOTE: To be able to compete in the State Finals, the youth bowler must have a 21 game average either from the previous year or from the current 2009-10 season. If from the 2009-10 season, the average for at least 21 games would be as of March 31, 2010. The March 31, 2010 average will be requested with their sign up information for the State Finals.
- AVERAGES – ADULT BOWLERS** – **HIGHEST VERIFIED** average from (1) the 2007-08 season of 21 or more games or (2) the 2008-09 season of 21 or more games or (3) the current verified average of 21 or more games. If the adult bowler has none of the above averages, he or she must bowl scratch (220).
- SUBSTITUTE BOWLERS** – Substitutes are not permitted at any level of this tournament. If for any reason an entrant is not able to advance to any subsequent level of competition with his/her partner, then his/her team spot will be forfeited and the team next in place will be eligible.
- All matters not covered by these House & Zone Rules will be handled by the Kansas State BPA Tournament Committee, and all decisions of same will be final.
- Kansas State scholarships will be awarded in both the Adult/Youth and Adult/Teen Divisions as follows:**  
**1<sup>st</sup> Place - \$500 Scholarship**  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Place - \$250 Scholarship**
